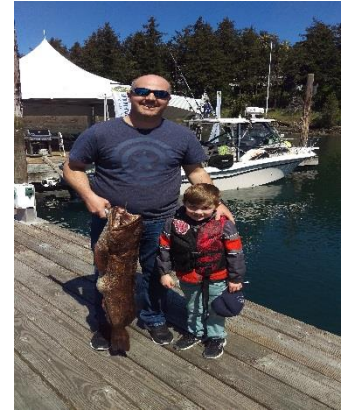

## Spring Rendezvous – Roche Harbor

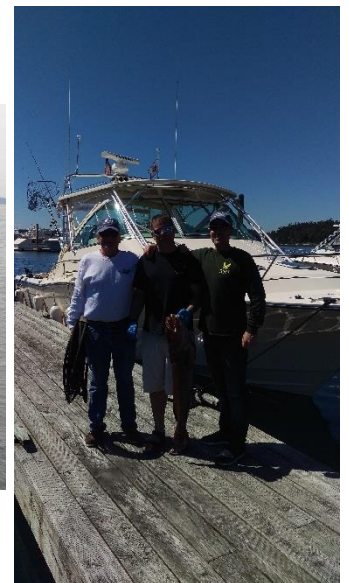
